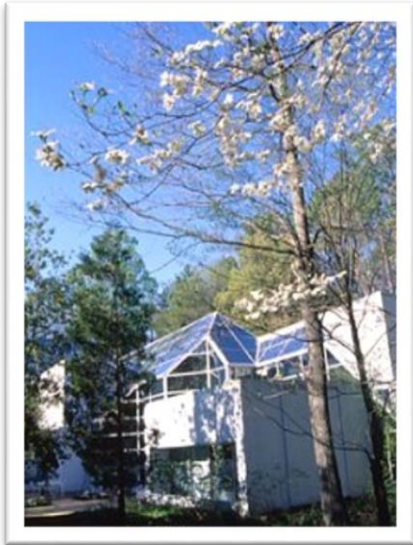




# Success Story

## A Non-Profit Institution



An American institute which is located in research Triangle Park of North Carolina, has dedicated itself to the study of humanities in all of its facets and forms. As result of these intellectual debates, almost a thousand books have been published.

When Milner first approached the institute, the institute did not have a sufficient IT infrastructure to allow for their scholars to properly interact and research nor did they have adequate security to protect their network from each point of entry.

Milner installed a robust firewall that was capable of spam control, web blocking, and application control. Then, to extend its reach Milner installed wireless access points to allow for dual band access with the freedom of accessing the network virtually anywhere in the building.

**To fix this Milner reformed their IT infrastructure to allow for increased ease of access while at the same time, providing for the necessary increase of security at each point of entry to the network.**

Once installed, Milner implemented VLAN's to allow for greater access outside to the building yet maintaining the integrity of the secured structure put into place.

Today, the IT infrastructure that Milner put into place is in full operation. Even after one other their visiting scholars clicked on a virus charged link from a unsolicited email the network remained in tacked, the repair took minutes instead of hours, and institute (as well as their in-house IT) was grateful.
